Other strategies:

1. use an adjective clause

2. describe the necessary conditions

3. use an appositive

Alan suffers from **Asperger's Syndrome**, **a condition which** is characterized by excessive attention to accuracy and detail combined with an almost complete lack of social skills.

4. define by contrast

Whereas rollerskating involves four wheels attached at opposite points along the sole of the skate, rollerblading involves wheels attached to the bottom on the skate in a straight line.
