



- 1.7 billion people without access to safe drinking water
- 10 million deaths annually
- 90% of infant deaths in developing countries




Water Issues

 - salts


Health Impacts

Some facts about Haiti

- Poorest country in the Western Hemisphere
- 148th in HDI (of 179)
- Second oldest republic in the Western Hemisphere (1804)
- Only successful slave revolt leading to independence
- Defeated Napoleon

Haiti

U.S.

- 53% have access to safe water...
- 54% live on less than \$1/day
- GNI/capita = \$440
- Rural population density = 664 (/km²)
- Annual deforestation rate = 5.7%
- Energy use/capita = 270 (kg oil equiv)

- 100% have access to safe water...
- <1% live on less than \$1/day
- GNI/capita = \$35,400
- Rural population density
 = 37 (/km²)
- Annual deforestation rate= -0.2%
- Energy use/capita = 7,996 (kg oil equiv)




